

16th Annual Bearcat Pull for Special Olympics

This year's challenge will involve SVPD's 17,500 pound LENCO Bearcat. A rope will be attached and each team will be required to pull the apparatus 25 feet! Each team is allowed two pulls. The team that pulls the Bearcat the fastest time in each category wins.

Trophies will be given for first, second, and third place in each category.

An additional trophy will be given to the team (or individual) that raises or donates the most money beyond the registration fee.

TEAMS

There will be four team categories. **Ironman:** 5 members | **Men:** up to 8 members **Women:** up to 10 members | **Coed:** 5 members of one gender and 4 of the other gender.

FAQS

Q: Do the team members have to pay the fee?

A: Teams may pay the registration fees in several different ways. Teams can have the members pay, find sponsors, or conduct fundraisers to raise the money.

Q: Who benefits?

A: All of the proceeds of this event benefit Special Olympics.

EARLY REGISTRATION

All teams that register prior to October 1, 2022 will receive T-shirts for all team members.

DAY OF EVENT

Teams are welcome to register the day of the event from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. No T-shirts will be given to teams that register after October 1, 2022, however, T-shirts *may* be purchased the day of the event (while supplies last). It is recommended that all participants use protective gloves. See the registration form on the back.

RULES

- 1. Each team cannot have any more members than what is authorized.
- 2. No team member substitutions after registration unless approved by the committee.
- 3. Registration is open to all who wish to participate.
- 4. All participants are required to read and sign a waiver. Anyone who fails or refuses to sign a release will not be allowed to participate.
- 5. The committee reserves the right to disqualify any participant(s) found under the influence of any drugs or alcohol. Fees will be forfeited.
- 6. No alcohol will be allowed on the premises during the event.
- 7. Registration fees are non-refundable. Any team that does not attend will forfeit their registration fee.
- 8. All registrations must be paid and received no later than October 1, 2022 in order to receive the T-shirts free of charge.
- 9. The committee has the final determination of winners in each category.
- 10. The committee has the right to deny or disqualify a registration from any team.
